When selecting which media to use for your large format prints, consider all the options. Choose from:

Matte coated paper: The paper is ideal for assignments that require good image quality at a modest cost. Matte coated paper provides a reliable choice for practical, limited-use business display applications such as:

- Courtroom exhibits
- Boardroom graphics
- Educational displays
- Window signage

Photo paper - high gloss & low glare: These papers are perfect for all of your high end applications and deliver extraordinary color reproduction. This media is ideal for:

- P O P displays
- Tradeshow displays
- Murals & posters
- Signs
- Exhibits & business graphics
- Photographic enlargements

UV compatible gloss photo paper: This paper is ideal for all of the above but provides extra protection against fading when used with UV inks.

Polycarbonate backprint (Lexan): Produce vibrant displays using this rigid polycarbonate film. Reverse imaging protects the print while the texture naturally diffuses light and cuts glare. This media is ideal for:

- Light box displays
- Backlit signs

This application with an opaque backing encapsulates and protects your image and provides outstanding tradeshow displays.

Canvas: When look and feel are critical to imaging, choose this fabric media to complement your image.

- Fine art reproductions
- Photo enlargements

Clear cling: Choose this media for eye catching window displays. The adhesive holds your graphics in place on glass and plexiglass but is easily removed and leaves no residue.
